New Business	UNT Redesigning Retirement (Gary Rahlfs) [additional educational opportunities about these changes will be forthcoming] Philosophy We want to recruit top talent We want to serve faculty with a secure plan We want to offer plans that are cost effective and efficient TRS and ORP TRS is the default plan, but certain positions here have the option to go to ORP Voluntary Plans Tex\$aver Coming as part of Phase II Tax Sheltered Annuity (TSA) The team is mainly looking at the 403(b) plans right now (OPR and the TSA) They are improving overall plans and the overall process There will be a new portal for management Fidelity is the lead record keeper (and one of the options) There are 4 tiers to choose from Tier 1 – Target Date Funds Tier 2 – Passively Managed Funds Tier 3 – Actively Managed Funds Tier 4 – Brokerage Option Tiers 1-3 will have about 30 choices of funds, Tier 4 is basically unlimited This better aligns us with other public universities Timelline Communication and trainings coming out now The new investment line will be available soon Fall 2018, meet with vendors, make changes January 2019, all updates/changes go into effect Questions/Comments This is for all current and new plans Mapping from old to new funds will occur on January 2 What about adding new vendors?
