2024 PIPER PROFESSOR AWARD UNT ELIGIBILITY AND NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

ELIGIBILITY: Must be nominated through college/university president's office. The candidate for the award may be a full-time instructor, program director, chair, or dean, but upper-level administrators **must have taught at least one course within the last five years**.

Required Nomination Materials:

- The completed and signed <u>Piper Professor Award nomination form</u> (College fills out part A, nominee fills out part B). NOTE: If additional space is needed in a section, insert "See Attachment # ____" in the section and use a Word document for this information with the corresponding attachment number. For additional information see the <u>Comptroller's website</u>.
 - Please Note: Per UNT's requirement, the President must also be a signatory on Part A, page 3. Accordingly, each nomination packet must include a completed Part A, page 3 <u>in duplicate</u> – one page signed by the department or college administrator (department-level administrator or dean) providing the information in Part A, and one page completed with the same information, but left unsigned.
- In addition to the two-part form, up to five letters of recommendation may also be submitted as part of the nomination. These letters may be from members of the nominee's administration, colleagues, and/or from current and former students of the nominee.
- Supplemental materials per the discretion of the nominee and nominating department, though the Piper Foundation advises *these materials should be limited*.
