3. A one-page statement of the nominee's teaching philosophy and perceptions of his/her teaching activities.
4. A tabulated summary of departmental teaching evaluations over the past five or more years which shows the nominee's relative standing in his/her department.
5. One year's worth of SPOT evaluations (the two most recent semesters)
6. Three letters of recommendation, including one from the nominee's Personnel Affairs Committee (PAC or LPAC) or any self-constituted ad hoc committee of three or more faculty members. A letter from the department chair or dean is optional but should be counted as one of the three letters.
