- 4. A tabulated summary of departmental teaching evaluations over the past five or more years which shows the nominee's relative standing in his/her department.
- 5. One year's worth of SPOT evaluations (the two most recent semesters)
- Three letters of recommendation, including one from the nominee's Personnel Affairs Committee (PAC or LPAC) or any selfconstituted ad hoc committee of three or more faculty members. A letter from the department chair or dean is optional but should be counted as one of the three letters.
